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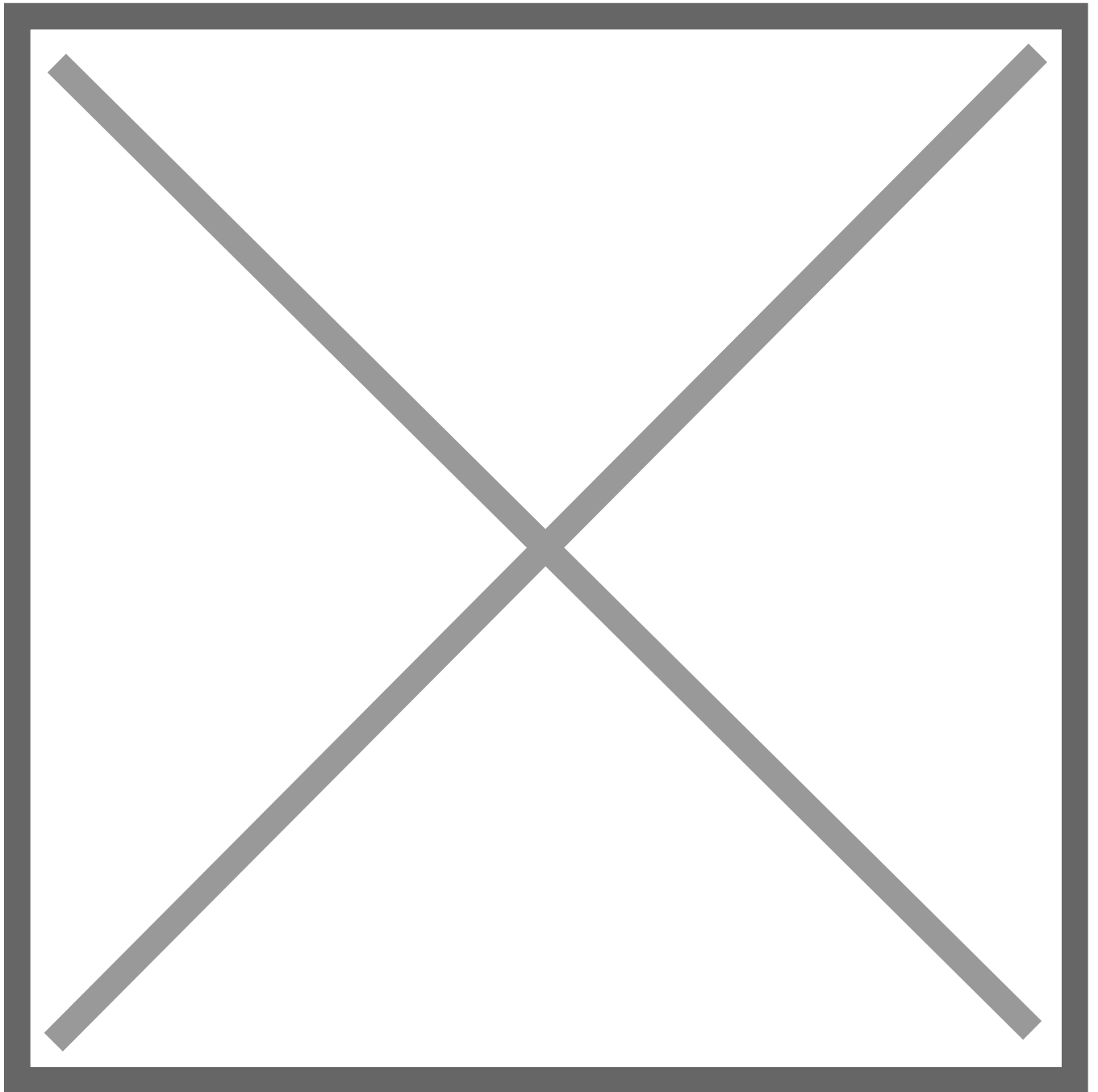

A-Ma Temple: One of the oldest temples in Macau dedicated to the Chinese sea goddess Mazu. The temple represents Macau's deep Chinese cultural heritage.

Macau Tower: A famous observation and entertainment tower offering panoramic city views and adventure activities like skywalk and bungee jumping.

Golden Lotus Square: A landmark square featuring the large Golden Lotus sculpture, symbolizing Macau's prosperity and reunification with China.

Day 5: Departure
