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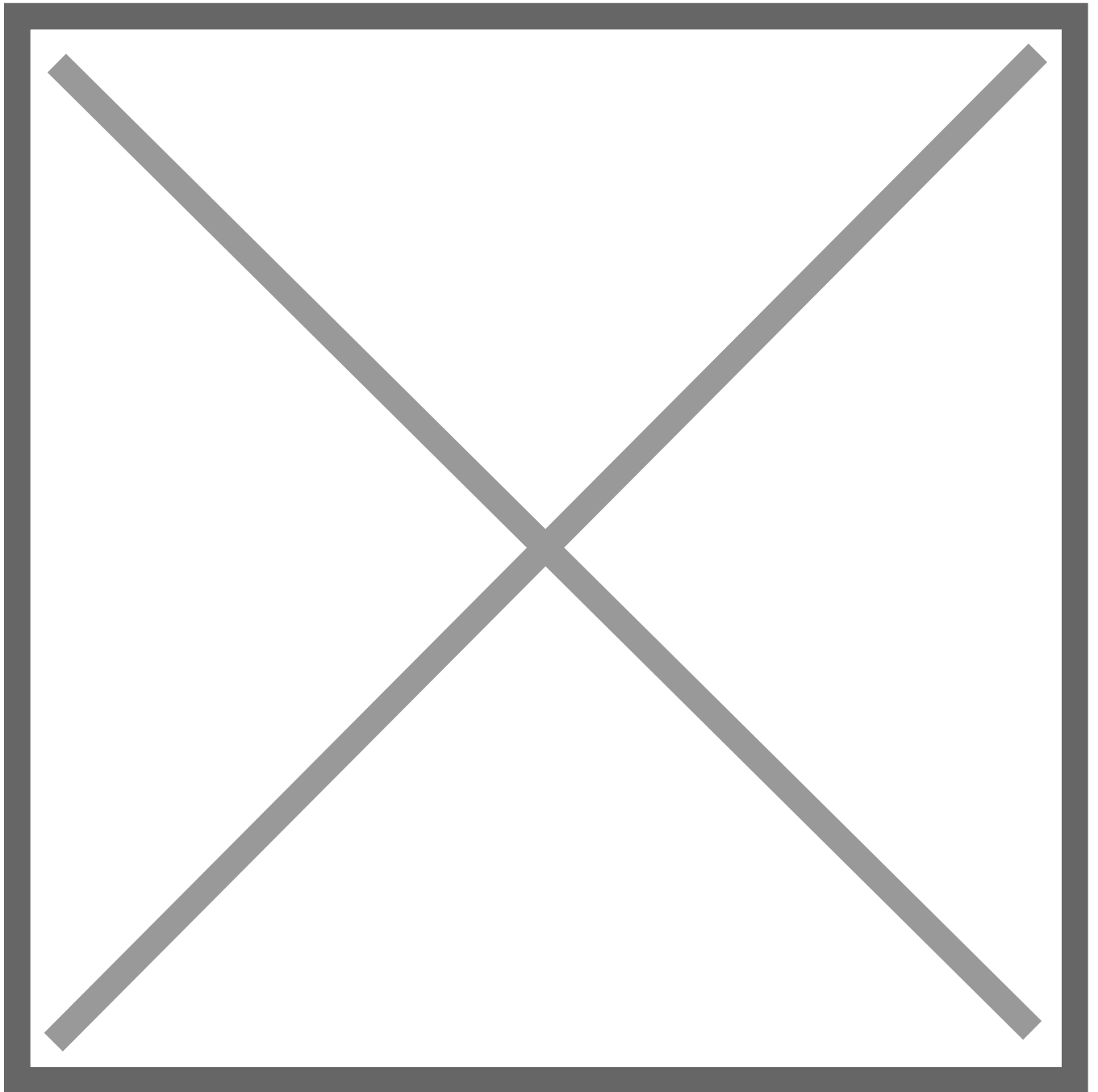

Tour Overview

Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1: Hong Kong City Tour + Symphony of Lights

Victoria Peak: Famous for unmatched skyline and harbour views from the city's highest viewpoint.

Star Ferry: Historic ferry ride offering classic harbour panoramas between Central and Tsim Sha Tsui.

Avenue of Stars: Waterfront promenade celebrating Hong Kong film industry legends.

Symphony of Lights: A nightly multimedia laser and light show illuminating the skyline around Victoria Harbour.

Day 2: Full Day Hong Kong Disneyland

Hong Kong Disneyland is a magical entertainment destination featuring exciting rides, Disney-themed attractions, live shows, parades, shopping, and family-friendly experiences across multiple themed lands.

Day 3: Lantau Island - Ngong Ping 360

Ngong Ping Village: Cultural village with traditional architecture, eateries, and souvenir shops.

Tian Tan Buddha: One of the world's largest seated outdoor Buddha statues symbolizing peace.

Po Lin Monastery: Serene Buddhist monastery known for its spiritual ambiance.

Day 4: Full Day Ocean Park Hong Kong

Ocean Park Hong Kong is a world-class marine-life and theme park offering thrilling rides, wildlife attractions, aquariums, live shows, and adventure zones for visitors of all ages.

Day 5: Ferry to Macau & Leisure

Transfer by ferry from Hong Kong to Macau. After hotel check-in, the day is free to explore casinos, shopping streets, or relax at the hotel.

Day 6: Macau City Tour

Fisherman's Wharf: A themed waterfront complex inspired by European architecture with shops and entertainment zones.

Golden Lotus Square: Landmark square featuring the Golden Lotus sculpture symbolizing prosperity.

Kum Lam Statue: A seaside statue dedicated to the Goddess of Mercy overlooking the harbour.

Ruins of St. Paul's: Iconic 17th-century church façade and UNESCO heritage landmark.

Senado Square: Portuguese-style mosaic square filled with shops and cafes.

A-Ma Temple: One of the oldest and most significant Chinese temples in Macau.

Day 7: Departure

Ferry back to Hong Kong and transfer to the airport with wonderful memories of skyline views, theme park adventures, scenic cable car rides, and Macau’s cultural heritage.
